Reporting Overview:

A trail status of cleared only means that the trees have been cut off at that point in time. Trails that have been cleared may continue to A trail status of cleared only means that the trees have been cut off at that point in time. Trails that have been cleared may continue to experience downfall after the reported clearing date. Trails that have been cleared of trees across the trail may still have heavy brush obstructing easy travel. If information for a trail or trail segment is not declared on this report, then that trail segment has not been scouted or maintained at this point in the season. Plans for maintaining trails constantly evolve; some trails may be maintained once in a season, or multiple times in a season, others may not be maintained at all in a given year. Also, note that trail conditions can change quickly after initial maintenance due to extreme weather conditions. Please be aware there may be snow on the trails at higher elevations. Caution should be used when evaluating water crossings. High and fast moving rivers and creeks may be encountered. Additionally, mid-summer high intensity rainstorms can cause sudden trail washouts.
